



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Shoreline Community College

and

The Honors College of Washington State University



Shoreline Community College (SCC) and Washington State University (WSU) hereby enter into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) pertaining to satisfaction of WSU Honors College requirements for bachelor's degrees.

This MOU is intended to eliminate duplication of coursework and better integrate programs to ensure a more efficient pathway to graduation through the WSU Honors College for students completing the Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA) or Associate in Science-Transfer (AS-T) degrees through the Shoreline Community College Transfer AA Honors Program.

Students who graduate from Shoreline Honors College with a DTA degree with a cumulative grade point of at least 3.50 and who are admitted to WSU will be guaranteed the following:

- Invitation into the WSU Honors College;
- \$2,000 in scholarship support from the WSU Honors College (a \$1K scholarship for the first year and a \$1K for students who engage in an approved experiential activity while at WSU, such as education abroad, internships, or research);
- Waiver of 100-and-200-level course requirements of the Honors College curriculum (the basic math and science requirements, English 298, Honors 270, Honors 280, and Honors 290).


DTA students transferring via this MOU would need only complete the three global competency courses (HONORS 370, 380, and 390), the foreign language requirement (which can be satisfied by course work, standardized test, or bilingualism), and the Honors thesis (waived for engineering and computer science majors) to complete their general education requirements through the WSU Honors College.

Students who graduate from the Shoreline Honors College with an AS-T degree and a cumulative grade point of at least 3.50 will be guaranteed all of the above except waiver of English 298, which will be considered case by case, contingent on whether the student has completed a research writing course.

If students transfer prior to completing the transfer degrees listed above, the acceptance of the courses toward a WSU degree will be based on WSU Transfer Equivalency Guidelines at www.transfercredit.wsu.edu and the individual degree programs as applicable. The details of this MOU may be changed at any time with the mutual written agreement of the participating institutions.






